

Workpack for Mr Foran's 5th Class WEEK March 30-April 03

Please NOTE* This is a suggested scheme of work for you to follow. It is a guideline and is designed to assist you in home-schooling your child during this very difficult period in our lives. Parents are encouraged to assist their children where and when they can but please do not feel under pressure to complete items if they are causing difficulty. All essential curriculum work will be caught up on when school resumes- the main thing is that children stay in touch with their learning and have a positive structure to their day over the course of the disrupted school term.

Please use a regular 88/120 page copy for work.

Label it HOME SCHOOL 2020.

Copy will be collected on return to school.

Try to vary the subject every 30-40 mins to help maintain your child's interest and concentration levels.

Also if you do a written piece, follow it with something oral, reading, research or an artistic exercise or even just a break before launching into another written assignment.

I would suggest working from around 9.30 and finishing around 1.00pm at latest. Use the afternoon for physical activity - play, walk, cycle, football, hurling, trampoline etc. etc.

PLEASE DO NOT FEEL THAT YOU HAVE TO DO EVERYTHING ON HERE, FEEL FREE TO GO IN WHATEVER DIRECTION WORKS FOR YOU, IF YOUR CHILD HAS A PARTICULAR INTEREST AREA LET THEM OFF, if they are researching get them to take notes, this is literacy at its most practical level – reading, writing and discovering.

English: Reading:

- Read Chapters 4, 5 of Novel (one chapter per 2 days)
- Drop Everything And Read Time: 20 mins a day.

Spellings: Children have this book at home

- Spellbound Week 23 & Complete all activities. Ensure all activities from previous units are completed up to and including Week 23
- Put each block of spellings into sentences each day
- Complete Test on Friday (Oral or Written)

Writing:

- Write a chapter summary of each chapter you read. (6-8 lines)
- Draw the illustration from the chapter into your copy, modify it if you want to
- Complete a procedural piece of writing on the topic "My Favourite Recipe"
Follow this format:
 - Title
 - Ingredients
 - Method
 - Your opinion

Complete one page of free writing each other day - any topic, any style.

Pick a topic which interests YOU. SAME LIST AS LAST WEEK - TWO IN A WEEK is plenty, do more if you wish.
