Reading:

- Read one chapter of the class novel each day.
- Drop Everything And Read Time: 30 mins a day. (A book of your choice)

- Revise poems learned so far this year(check folder/online if necessary)

Spellings:

- Next unit of spellbound and all activities (21 for those on spellbound 6)
- Dictionary words for all spellings: write into copy
- Complete Test on Friday

Writing:

- Pick one writing topic per day from the following and complete in your copy
 1. Book review of the last book you have read.(Novel or other)
 2. A recipe including instructions and ingredients.
 3. A letter to someone you haven't been able to see in a while.
 4. Reasons for and against school summer holidays starting at the end of July this year.(5 of each).
 5. A personal diary entry detailing how you have spent your day.
- If you have access to a device/ internet: *All write now cursive level D* (folens online) copy one page per day, take this opportunity to revise and improve their cursive script.
