English:

Reading:

- Read Chapters 1, 2 and 3 of Novel (one chapter per day)
- Drop Everything And Read Time: 20 mins a day.

Spellings:

- Spellbound Week 22 Complete all activities. Ensure all activities from previous units are completed up to and including Week 22
- Put each block of spellings into sentences each day
- Complete Test on Friday (Oral or Written)

Writing:

- Write a chapter summary of each chapter you read. (6-8 lines)
- Draw the illustration from the chapter into your copy, modify it if you want to

Complete one page of free writing each day - any topic, any style Pick a topic which interests YOU

- *narrative prose (traditional story) e.g. A Wonderful Adventure*
- *comic strip e.g. April Fool's Day - Best Prank Ever!*
- *Poetry - You Gotta Love Dogs*
- *list of instructions - Lego Technic - How to Construct a (Pick the Model yourself)*
- *daily diary- Covid 2020 My Experience*
- *report - News from My House Today*
- *letter to Lidl - Where has all the Pasta Gone?*
- *summary- Novel e.g. Holes*
- *recipes - Delicious Dad Dinner*
- Complete a persuasive piece of writing on the topic
